DESCRIPTION

Homestead Rubble Elkton Ridge is an oversized irregular ledgerstone. It is intended to replicate the appearance of natural stone used in early era buildings. It has various sandy tans as well as some dark brown spotters. Corners are generally more squared than the flats in this blend. It is typically installed with a mortar joint, but it may be installed in a dry-stacked style with additional cutting and fitting.
